## The Boconnoc Grass Autotest Saturday August 11<sup>th</sup> 2018 Supplementary Regulations

### 1. SPORTING REGULATIONS - GENERAL

#### 1.1 TITLE AND JURISDICTION

The Boconnoc Grass Autotest is organised and administered by Plymouth Motor Club in accordance with the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (MSA) (and incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations & any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event. The venue is the Boconnoc Estate Lostwithiel, Cornwall.

#### 1.3 COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY

- 1.3.1 Competitors must be fully paid up members of Plymouth MC, South Hams MC, Camel Vale MC, Truro & District MC, Newquay AC, Exmouth MC, Exeter MC, Silverton MC, N Devon MC, Tavern MC, Bournemouth & District MC, Holsworthy MC, Burnham-on-Sea MC, Weston-super-Mare MC or Taunton MC. *All competitors must produce a valid Club Membership card when signing-on.*

#### 1.4 ENTRIES

- 1.4.1 Entries will be accepted on a first come basis. All entries must be made on the official Entry Form below and accompanied by the appropriate fee.
- 1.4.1 The Entry Fee will be:- £10. Cheques payable to:- **Boconnoc Motorsport**
- 1.4.2 The closing date for Entries is 11<sup>th</sup> August 2018 @15:00hrs. Entries may be given by e-mail or telephoning the Entries Secretary. An Entry Form must be completed at the latest at signing-on before the start of the competition.
- 1.4.4 Any Instructions will be issued on the day of the Event.
- 1.4.5 Maximum entries will be: 25.
- 1.4.6 Entries may be accepted from Drivers who are over 14 years of age in the Production Class only; however, the passenger must hold a full RTA licence & be a member of one of the invited clubs & be experienced in Autotesting.

#### 1.5 EVENT PROGRAMME

- Entries open:- on publication of these regulations & closes 1500hrs 11<sup>th</sup> August, 1 hour before 1<sup>st</sup> car starts.
- Scrutineering & Signing-on: - Opens at 1530hrs (Details of the tests will be issued at signing-on)
- Ist Car Starts: - 1600hrs. The Event will finish at approx: - 1900hrs
- Any Competitor not signed-on by the start of the first car, may be excluded.
- Results will be published as soon as possible after the event.
- 1.5.1 Awards will be given for FTD & 1<sup>st</sup> in each class (**subject to 3 starters in each class**).
- 1.5.2 Awards will be given out on completion of the Stage Rally, at the awards ceremony on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2018.

## **2. SPORTING REGULATIONS – JUDICIAL PROCEDURES.**

2.1 Protests must be lodged in accordance with C5.

## **3. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS**

### **3.1 CLASSES**

**The organisers have the right to combine classes.**

Class A Cars up to 12ft 6ins overall length

Class B Cars over 12ft 6 ins overall length

Class C Sports cars, kits cars, four-wheel-drive vehicles and specials.

Class D Production Class. Age of Driver 14 years + & must carry a passenger that holds a full RTA licence to give instructions to the driver. (If the driver holds a full RTA licence, the passenger must be over 12 years of age & be a member of one of the invited clubs)

3.2 All vehicles are to comply with the safety requirements in sections E & L of MSA Yearbook 2018.

3.3 Competitor vehicles need not be road taxed.

3.4 Cars will be identified by a number on the side window of the car.

### **4. TESTS**

4.1 Details of the tests will be issued at signing on.

4.2 Tests may require the use of reverse gear (other than Production Class).

4.3 Tests will be timed to 1/10<sup>th</sup> of a second by hand-held stopwatches.

4.4 Time permitting, each driver will have a minimum of two runs at each test to count for results. The start will be in the drivers own time when the marshal signals he/she is ready. All runs to count for results.

4.5 Practicing will not be allowed, but competitors will be allowed to walk the course.

4.6 Marking & Penalties will be as follows:-

Time taken in test (minute, second & part of):-	Equals time awarded.
Striking a Marker (cone or barrier):-	10second Penalty per mistake
Not starting or performing the test correctly:-	30 second Penalty per test
Failing to cross or stop at any specified line:-	10second Penalty per mistake

4.7 Passengers are not allowed on Autotests on any timed runs except production class where a passenger must be carried in all timed tests.

4.8 All other MSA General Regulations apply except: M4.2 - Pylons/cones may be less than 1 metre in height.
