Supplementary Regulations

1. Plymouth Motor Club will organise a Clubman Autotests on 25th July and 8th August 2018. The events will be held in a grass field at MR. 202/551631
2. The meeting will be governed by the general regulations of the MSA Ltd, these supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event
3. MSA permit number TBA
4. The event will be open to fully paid-up members of Plymouth Motor Club.
5. All competitors must show a valid membership card at signing on.
6. Classes
Clubman event:-

<u>Class A</u>	cars up to 12ft 6 inches in length
<u>Class B</u>	cars over 12ft 6 inches in length
<u>Class C</u>	Sports cars, kit cars, specials

The minimum entry for a class is 3. The organizers have the right to amalgamate classes as necessary .
7. Schedule
Entries open on publication of these regulations and close at 18:00 on the day of the event.

8. Timetable
Signing on /scrutineering open at 17:00.
First car starts at 18:00.
Last car will finish at 20:00 approx.
9. The entry fee is £20.
10. Awards will be presented at the annual Plymouth Motor Club awards presentation evening as follows:

FTD	an award	
1 st in class	an award	(subject to 3 starters in class)
2 nd in class	an award	(subject to 5 starters in class)
3 rd in class	an award	(subject to 8 starters in class)

The maximum number of entries for this event & the production car autotest that will be running at the same time as this event will be 15.
11. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event.
12. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5
13. Practicing will not be allowed but competitors can walk the course
14. Details of the tests will be provided at signing on. All tests will be on grass.
15. Forest/snow/4x4 type tyres are not allowed. you will be refused a start or excluded if caught using them
16. The number of tests & the number of attempts will be notified on the day.
17. Vehicles need not be taxed.
18. The organizers reserve the right to cancel the event due to bad weather before or and on the day of the meeting.

19. Timing will be by held stop watches to 1/10th of the second. The start will be in the drivers own time when the marshal signals he/she is ready. All runs count towards the results. Penalties will be applied as per M.7 of the 2018 "Blue book".
20. Passengers are not allowed.
